The Sylis Group generated €33.7 million in revenues over Q2 2006, up 9.1% on Q2 2005 (published), despite the number of working days being 3% lower than the same period in 2005.

On a constant structural basis (acquisition of Profinity in January 2006 and sale of SBS in March 2006), growth for the first half of the year comes out at 4.7% compared with H1 2005. Over this period, business grew 3.5% in France and 7.8% in the Benelux – notably driven by Belgium, with organic growth of over 10%.

In Q2, the occupancy rate rose 0.7% in relation to Q1 2006, with further improvements forecast for the second half of the year.

The Group confirms that the higher level of revenues generated will have a significant positive impact on earnings for the first half of 2006.

Outlook

In light of the growing shortage of resources on the IT job market, the Group has strengthened its recruitment capabilities across all of its regions in order to be in sync with the commercial developments that have enabled Sylis to resume growth over the first six months of 2006.

Today, Sylis confirms its double-digit growth target for 2006.
